The following is a report of the homeless the program help this past year and the services provided to them.

St. Bernadette Parish will be hosting homeless men and women in our hall from the evening of March 28th through the morning of April 3rd.

Duration of the Season: November 11, 2003 to April 6, 2004 (men only 11/10 – 12/21)

Nights of Operation: 147 (91 nights of single site operation; 56 of dual site operation.)

Total sheltered at some time during the season: 120 (103 males and 17 females)

New and Returning Guests: 77 new this year (64% new); 43 returning (36% alums)

Total Bed nights: 4,439

Total Meals provided: 14,787

Average Nightly Headcount for the season: 32.2
