Duration of the season: November 8, 2004 to April 3, 2005 (co-ed from Dec.13, 2004)
Nights of Operation: 147 (84 nights of single site operation; 63 nights of dual site operation)
Total sheltered at some time during the season: 136 (122 men, 14 women)
New and returning guests: 78 new this year (57%); 58 returning this year (43%)
Total bed nights: 5,019
Total meals provided: 15, 057
