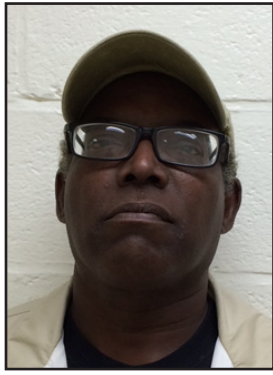


Every journey begins with a single step...

Struggling with a drug and alcohol addiction since he was twelve years old, he has been clean for 7 months. He never thought he would be able to come clean, but with the help of Arundel House of Hope and the good Lord, he has been able to turn his life around. Currently housed in one of our transitional homes, Johnny hopes to get his own apartment and renew his driver’s license in the near future. He dreams of expanding his horizons by traveling, as well as continuing his lifelong love of race car driving. Way to go Johnny!

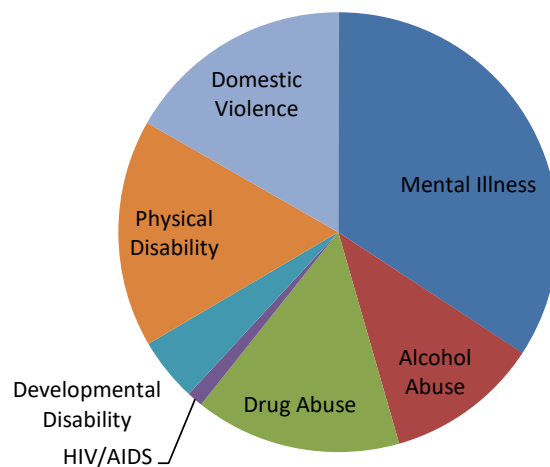

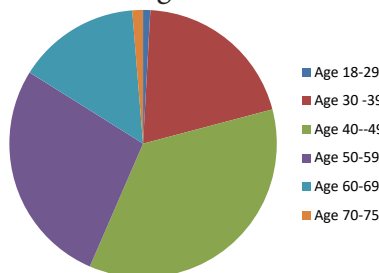

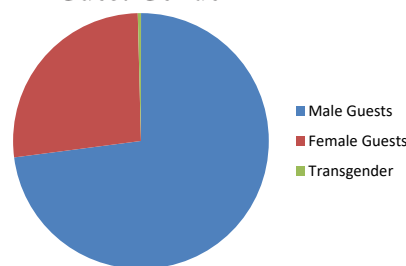
